Professor Bee Chen Goh is the first Malaysian woman Rhodes Scholar. She specialized in International Law at Cambridge, and is a Fellow of the Cambridge Commonwealth Society. She was a Visiting Researcher at the Harvard Law School in the Summer of 1993. She is a Fellow of the Society for Advanced Legal Studies, London.



Bee Chen's particular teaching and research interests are International Law, with a special focus on International Law of Peace, Alternative Dispute Resolution (especially on Chinese, and Cross-cultural Negotiation, and traditional Chinese mediation), and Contract Law. In the field of Chinese Negotiation (also the focus of her doctoral thesis), Bee Chen has published, and presented papers in Australia, New Zealand, the People's Republic of China, Hong Kong, Malaysia and Norway.

Bee Chen is well-versed in English, Mandarin, Malay/Indonesian, Hokkien (Taiwanese) and Cantonese. Since arriving at Southern Cross University, Bee Chen has also assumed the following roles:

- Advisory Board Member of the Centre for Children & Young People,
- Advisory Board Member of the Aged Services Learning and Research Collaboration,
- Inter-Faith Committee Member.
