

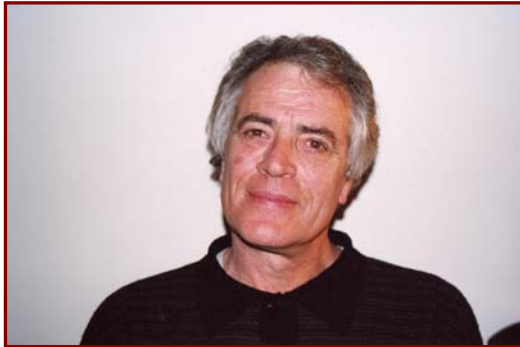
2007 BYRON BAY WRITERS FESTIVAL

Robert Hillman is the author of four novels, including *The Hour of Disguise* (Simon and Schuster, 1990) and *The Deepest Part of the Lake* (Scribe, 2001). His memoir, *The Boy in the Green Suit*, won the 2005 National Biography Award.
